

Scavenger Hunt

Recommended for all ages, including adults!

Outdoor English lesson activity to increase students' well-being; physical and mental status.

To carry out this activity you will need:

- Accessible outdoor environment
- Laminator for papers
- Digital tool (optional)
- Bag to bring back objects (optional)

First you scan your area for suitable natural or other things for the students to find. Objects to find nouns such as stone, leaf, stick pine cone. You can also look for adjectives, such as long, sharp, round, red, grey, wet, sticky, furry etc.

Then you make a list which is suitable for the age of your students, print and laminate the paper so it does not tear, then you can reuse it too.

Divide your students into groups of 2-3, give them the list and send them out. If your using a digital tool the students can take photos of the objects, otherwise they collect them in a bag and bring them back to you.

When the students come back, they give an oral account of their findings.
